Because the IEEE Computer Society is dedicated to environmental responsibility, we've asked our printer to change from a UV-coated cover stock to an aqueous coating. The ultraviolet lamps used in the UV coating process require additional energy, and the chemicals in the UV coating not only raise worker safety issues at the printing plant but also prevent efficient recycling. An aqueous coating, on the other hand, can be freely recycled and re-pulped without harmful byproducts. This is a modest but effective step toward minimizing the environmental impact of our publications.

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
